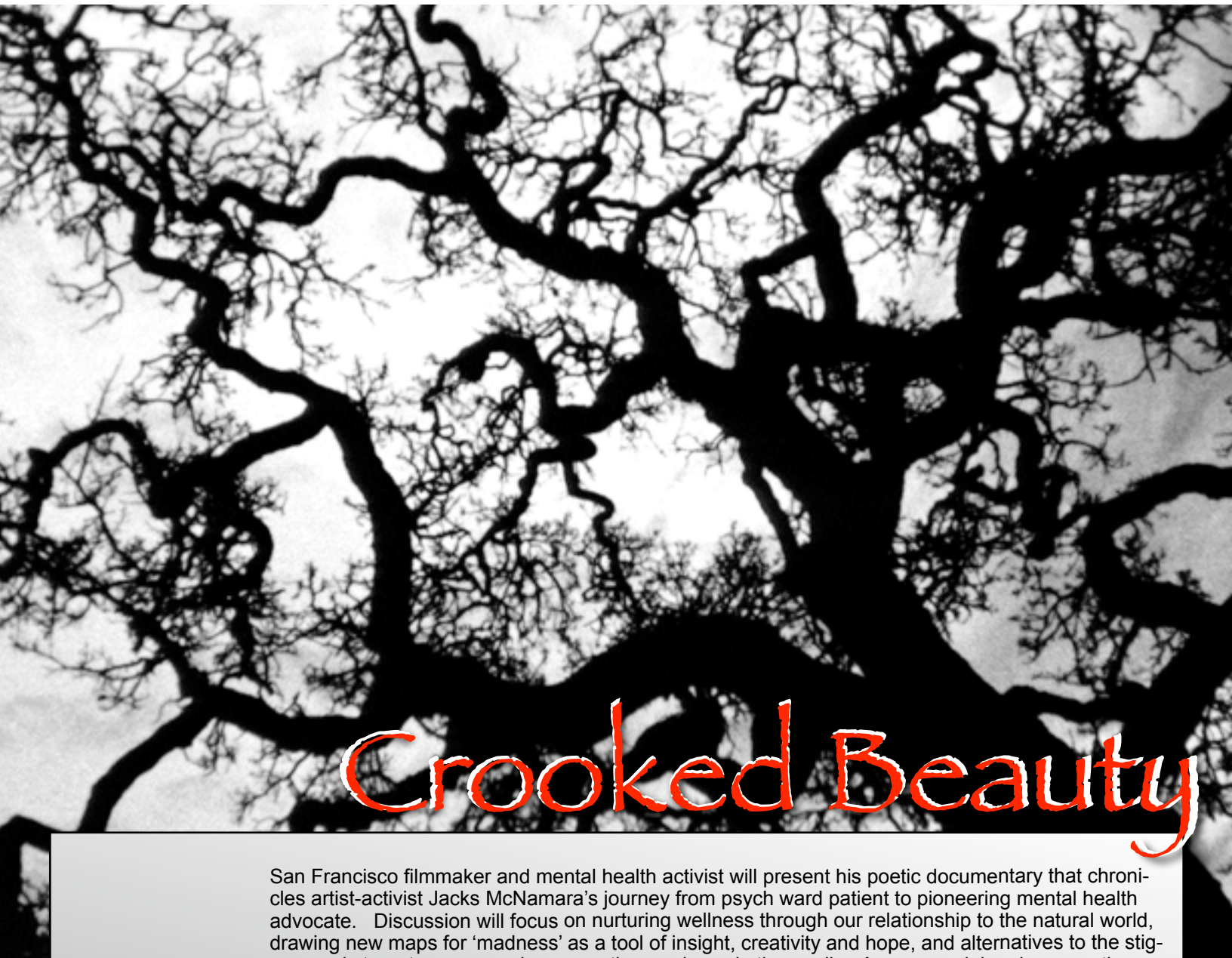


MOVIE MONDAY
