By local boys Sam Dunn and Scott McFadyen who've made a name for themselves worldwide with a series

of terrific metal documentaries. This 2009 film follows I M on an incredible power world tour from the inside.

So you want to cover the world? You modify a Boeing 757 to take 12 tons of music and stage equipment on board, playing 23 sold out stadium and arena shows in 13 countries in just 45 days, travelling 70,000km and performing to almost half a million fans - with lead singer Bruce Dickinson, a licensed pilot, at the helm. It's an amazing story told brilliantly. You don't need to like metal music to have a great time with this film, I don't and I did.
