Inspired by the fantastic films of Ray Harryhausen, and with a professional career that started in Victoria in the mid-1970s, Bill Maylone ended up directing or creating animated movies and sequences for the likes of Adbusters, the National Film Board, NOVA, the CBC, and Will Vinton Studios.

In the days before computer animation, dinosaurs and other fantastic creatures were brought to life most effectively using the painstaking hands-on technique of stop-motion animation.

Bill will share his stories, images, movies, and models and talk about the challenges, successes, and frustrations involved in being driven by the unusual, but - fortunately - constructive obsession of making inanimate objects appear to be alive.

He came to realize that this odd profession could actually contribute to changing the world.
