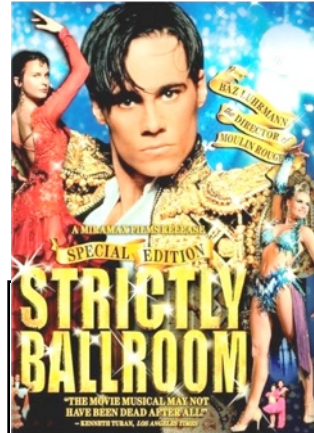

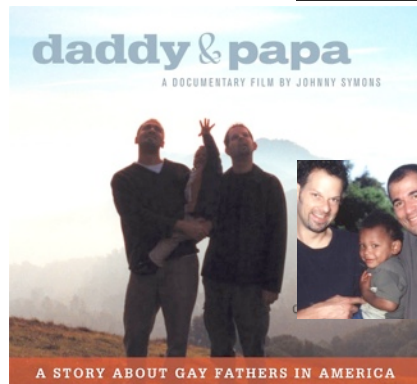


DAUGHTER OF CHAOS
