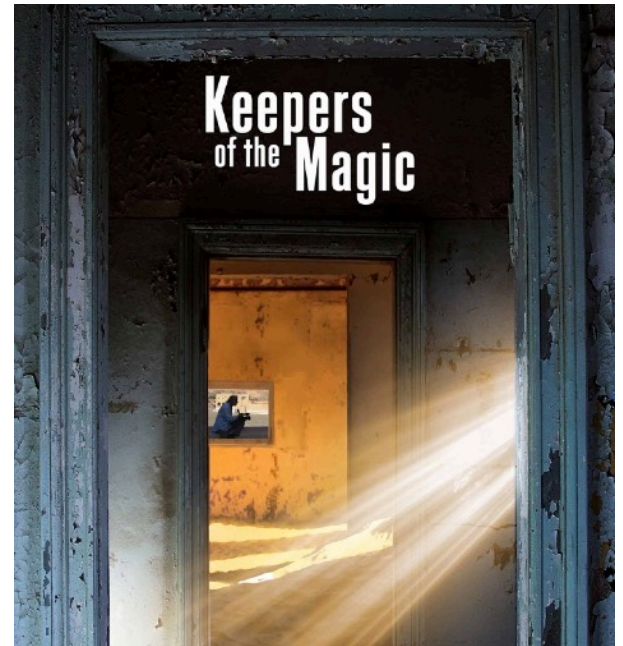

Our guest Vic Sarin is one of Canada's most celebrated filmmakers, earning world renown as one of our premier cinematographers. As a director, Sarin has won recognition for feature films such as Partition, A Shine of Rainbows and Cold Comfort and documentaries such as; Boy from Geita, Hue: A Matter of Colour, and Desert Riders.

Two MM faves, Margaret's Museum and Bye Bye Blues are among 150 projects he has worked on as Director of Photography. His latest film Keepers of the Magic is a personal passion project to Sarin; creating a distinct look and feel with unique storytelling that seamlessly weave together the emotional and visual aspects of his films.
