request, passed the following Motion:

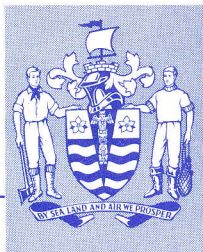
"THAT a grant of \$3,000 be approved and the Director
